Third party attestation related to products, processes, systems or persons"

Attestation – "Issue of a statement based on a decision following review that fulfillment of specified requirements have been demonstrated"



Examination of a product design, product, process or installation and determination of its conformity with specific requirements or, on the basis of professional judgement, with general requirements.


# Testing Laboratory Services Division

## **Accreditation**

#### **Definition**

Third-party attestation related to a conformity assessment body conveying formal demonstration of its competence to carry out specific conformity assessment tests.

## **Lab Accreditation**

30 Steps are required for international recognition as a National Accreditation body (NAB). These include

- National policy on Quality
- Management structure
- Equipment
- Quality documentation
- ✓ Independency
- ✓ Lead assessors
- ✓ Technical assessors
- Metrology Support in Country and
- ✓ MLA / MRA.

#### Lab Accreditation

- Majority of steps have been planned or are in progress.
- Almost half of the steps are completed or nearly finished.
- Independency (Impartially), Metrology support, Technical Experts trained in Assessment should be concluded by 2006
